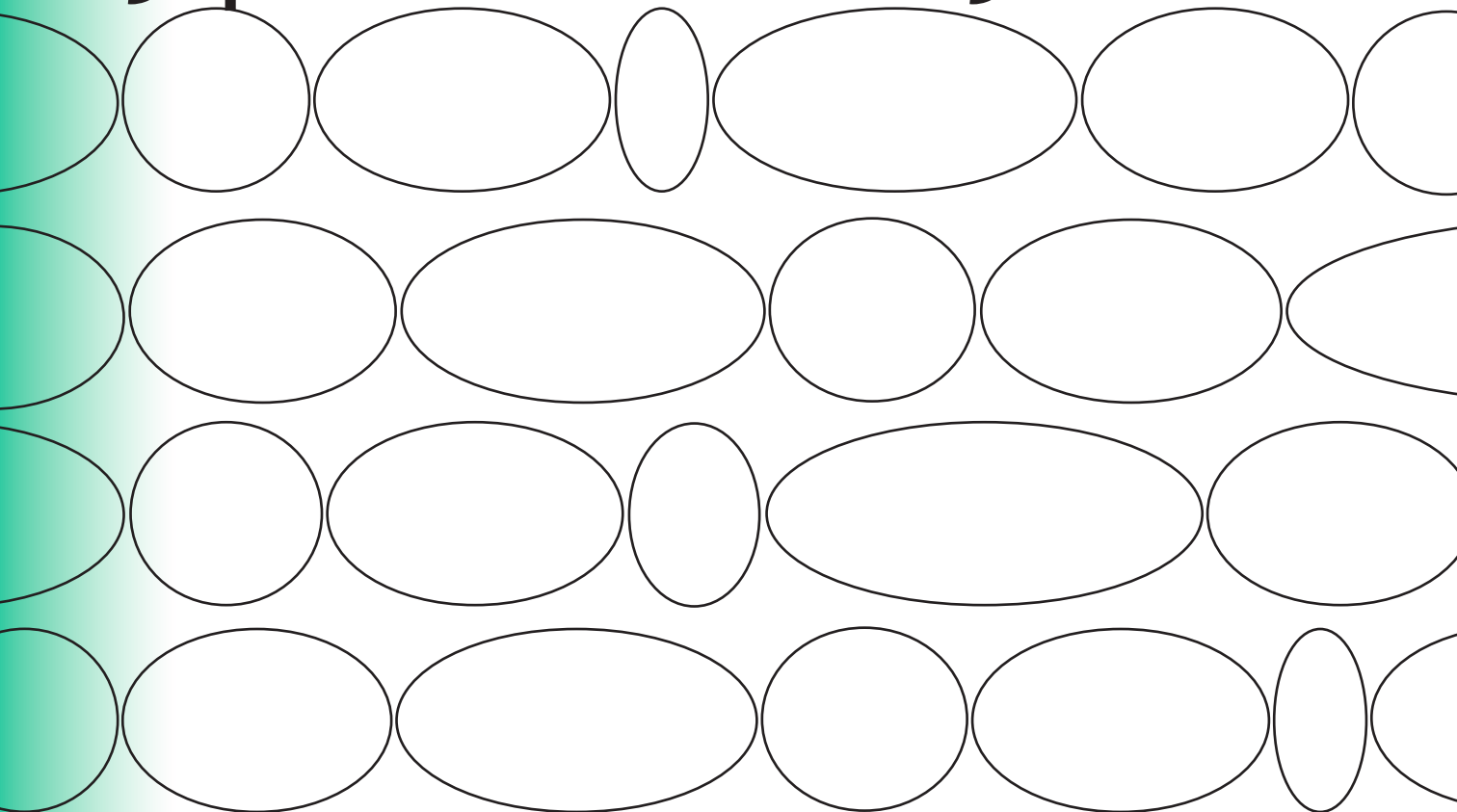

SUVA Type Foundry Specimen No. 1 introduces a selection of fonts from the web platform and various printed matter, where the fonts have been used.

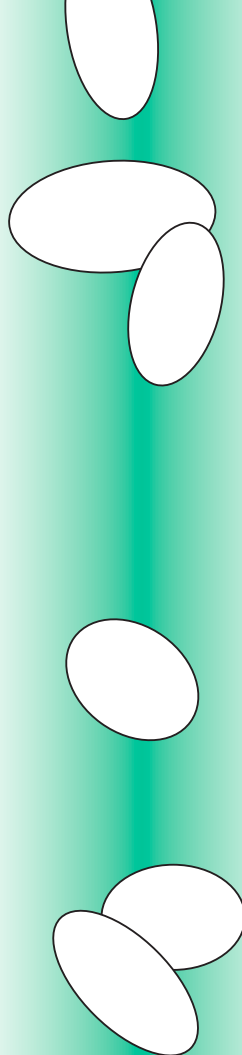
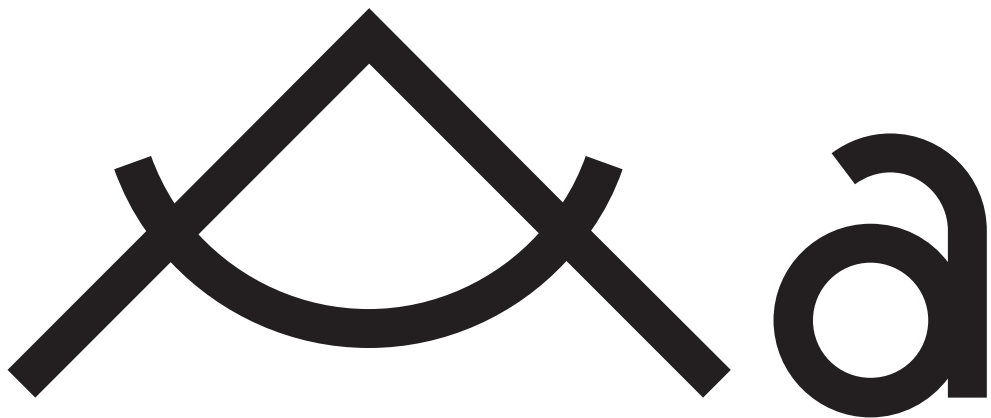

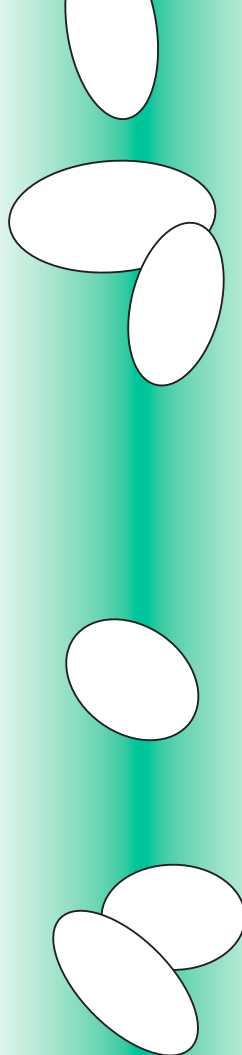
They are now considered to be a large part of popular culture in the west. In 2015, Oxford Dictionaries named the Face with Tears of Joy emoji the Word of the Year.

The development of emoji was predated by text-based emoticons, as well as graphical representations, inside and outside of Japan.

The first emoji was created in 1999 in Japan by Shigetaka Kurita. He was part of the team working on NTT DoCoMo's i-mode mobile Internet platform.
